Hopefully they will be reunited with their families but, if not, they will be sent to different areas of the country.

Carol said that she could reach out to Mother Julia who has a wealth of experience and knowledge and is currently working to support those at the Fort McCoy, one of eight military bases that are housing people who are refugees from Afghanistan.

We agreed that that would be wonderful.
